Eligibility Criteria

- Arab/MENA heritage OR proven interest/experience in the MENA region
- Current/Prospective full-time enrollment* in an accredited**
 MBA program***
- Demonstrated interest in pursuing a business/finance career
- Strong Academic Standing (GMAT score of 600+ or equivalent)
- Financial need

^{*}The scholarship is to be applied to the next school year. Those who are already enrolled or who are in the process of applying as full-time students are both eligible; proof of enrollment in the next school year will be requested/verified when available. Students graduating at the end of the current school year are not eligible. **Accredited by the AACSB or the ACBSP. ***May be a joint/dual program but no Executive MBAs.
